Barnes County Two-vehicle Injury Crash

What: Injury

Where: 112th Ave SE and 24th St (Approximately 1 mile east of Rogers)

When: June 19, 2025; 10:09am CT

Road Conditions: Good

Weather Conditions: Good

Crash Involvement: Vehicle vs Vehicle

Type of Crash: T-bone

Agencies Involved: NDHP, Barnes County Sheriff's Department, Branes County Ambulance

Vehicle No. 1: 1994 Dodge Ram
Driver No. 1: Female, 16, Hannaford; serious life-threatening injuries
Restraints: No seatbelt
Charges: Under investigation

Vehicle No. 2: 2012 Peterbilt Semi Driver No. 2: Paul Amann, 68, Eckelson; not injured Restraints: Seatbelt Charges: Under investigation

NARRATIVE: On June 19, 2025, at 10:09 a.m. CT, a Dodge Ram was traveling southbound on 112th Ave SE, and a Peterbilt was traveling westbound on 24th Street. 112th Ave SE is controlled by stop signs for both northbound and southbound traffic. The Dodge Ram failed to stop at the stop sign and entered the intersection, striking the rear passenger trailer tank of the Peterbilt in a T-bone style collision. Driver 1 was not wearing a seat belt and sustained serious, life-threatening injuries as a result of the crash. Paul Amann was uninjured in the crash.

The identity of the juvenile will not be released. This incident remains under investigation by the North Dakota Highway Patrol.
