## **Cass County Serious Injury Crash**

**What:** Serious Injury

**Where:** I94 MM 334, 2 miles east of Casselton

**When:** March 18, 2025, 4:00 PM CST

**Road Conditions:** Good

**Weather Conditions:** Cloudy

**Crash Involvement:** Vehicle

**Type of Crash:** Rollover

**Agencies Involved:** North Dakota Highway Patrol, Cass County Sheriff's Department, Casselton Ambulance

**Vehicle No. 1:** 2005 Acura MDX

**Driver No. 1:** Sixty-two-year-old female, West Fargo, North Dakota

**Restraints:** Seatbelt/Airbag

### **NARRATIVE:**

On March 18, 2025 at 4:00 PM CT, an Acura was westbound in the left lane of I94 at mile marker 334 and entered the median where it over-corrected. It then re-entered the roadway and rolled across both westbound lanes before entering the north ditch and coming to final rest. The driver was transported to Sanford Hospital in Fargo by Casselton Ambulance with suspected serious injury.

The crash remains under investigation by the North Dakota Highway Patrol.
