Driver No. 1: Male, 47, Rugby, not injured

Vehicle No. 2: 2025 Chevrolet Blazer

Driver No. 2: Female, 88, Esmond, injured

**Restraints:** Seat belt in use **Charges:** Under investigation

**NARRATIVE:** On November 11, 2025, at approximately 1:25 p.m., a 2025 Chevrolet Blazer was traveling southbound on Highway 3 near mile marker 189. A 2005 Sterling LT9500 was traveling westbound from a gravel township road and entered Highway 3. The Sterling struck the Blazer in a T-bone collision.



Driver 2 sustained serious injuries and was transported by Rugby Ambulance to a local medical facility. Driver 1 was not injured.

The crash remains under investigation by the North Dakota Highway Patrol.
