## PIERCE COUNTY INJURY CRASH UPDATE

Vehicle No. 1: 2005 Sterling LT9500

**Driver No. 1: Leo Adam,** 47, Rugby, not injured

**Restraints:** No seat belt in use **Charges:** Under investigation

Vehicle No. 2: 2025 Chevrolet Blazer

**Driver No. 2:** Jane Wolfe, 88, Esmond, injured

**Restraints:** Seat belt in use **Charges:** Under investigation

**NARRATIVE:** On November 11, 2025, at approximately 1:25 p.m., a 2025 Chevrolet Blazer driven by Jane Wolfe, was traveling southbound on Highway 3 near mile marker 189. A 2005 Sterling LT9500 driven by Leo Adam was traveling westbound from a gravel township road and entered Highway 3. The Sterling struck the Blazer in a T-bone collision.



Wolfe sustained serious injuries and was transported by Rugby Ambulance to a local medical facility. Adam was not injured.

The crash remains under investigation by the North Dakota Highway Patrol.
