MORTON COUNTY INJURY CRASH

What: Injury Crash

Where: I-94, MM 115 (westbound), east of Glen Ullin

When: Wednesday, October 1, 4:59 PM Central Time

Road Conditions: Dry

Weather Conditions: Dry

Crash Involvement: Single vehicle

Type of Crash: Fixed object

Agencies Involved: NDHP, Morton County Sheriff's Office, Glen Ullin Ambulance, Metro Ambulance, Glen Ullin Fire

Vehicle No. 1: 2011 Chevy Traverse

Driver No. 1: Female, 61, Hebron, serious injury

Restraints: Seatbelt in use

Charges: Under investigation

NARRATIVE: On Wednesday, October 1, 2025, at approximately 4:59 PM, a 2011 Black Chevy Traverse was traveling westbound on I-94 near mile marker 115. The Traverse left the roadway, entered the median, then vaulted off an embankment between the eastbound and westbound bridge decks and coming to rest in a slough. The driver sustained serious injuries and was transported to CHI-St. Alexius in Bismarck.

The crash remains under investigation by the NDHP.
