## **Emmons County Injury Crash**

What: Injury

Where: Hwy 34 MM 8, Intersection of Hwy 34 and 15th Ave SE, 6 miles south of Braddock

When: September 6, 2025, at 11:03 a.m. CT

**Road Conditions:** Good

Weather Conditions: Good

Crash Involvement: Vehicle vs Tractor

**Type of Crash:** T-bone

Agencies Involved: North Dakota Highway Patrol, Emmons County Sheriff's Department,

Braddock Fire, Hazelton Fire, Napolean Ambulance, Sanford Air Med

**Vehicle No. 1:** 2024 Chevrolet Silverado towing camper

Driver No. 1: 81, male, Bismarck, injured

**Restraints:** Seatbelt in use **Charges:** Under investigation

**Vehicle No. 2:** Unknown year John Deere Tractor

Driver No. 2: Male, 24, Linton, injured

**Restraints:** N/A

**NARRATIVE:** On September 6, 2025, at approximately 11:03 a.m., a Chevrolet Silverado was traveling southbound on 15th Avenue SE approaching the intersection with Highway 34. A John Deere tractor was traveling eastbound on Highway 34 and was slowing to make a left turn to head north on 15th Avenue SE into Braddock.

The driver of the Chevrolet Silverado disregarded the stop sign, entered the intersection, and struck the tractor on its driver's side. The impact ejected the tractor driver, who sustained serious, life-threatening injuries. The tractor driver was airlifted to Sanford Medical Center in



Bismarck. The driver of the Chevrolet Silverado suffered minor injuries and was transported by ambulance to CHI St. Alexius Health.

This crash remains under investigation by the North Dakota Highway Patrol.
