BOTTINEAU COUNTY FATAL CRASH

What: Fatal Crash

Where: 93rd St. NW & 18th Ave. NW, approximately 4 miles Northeast of Maxbass

When: Tuesday, September 9, approximately 11:30 AM CT

Road Conditions: Dry

Weather Conditions: Good

Crash Involvement: Two vehicle crash

Type of Crash: T-bone

Agencies Involved: NDHP, Bottineau County Sheriff's Office, Maxbass Fire and Rescue, Westhope Ambulance Service

Vehicle No. 1: 2007 Chevrolet Silverado

Driver No. 1: Male, 43, Antler, ND, fatal injuries

Restraints: Seatbelt not in use

Vehicle No. 2: 2015 Case IH 4440 Sprayer

Driver No. 2: Male, 43, Kenmare, ND, not injured

Restraints: Seatbelt in use

NARRATIVE: On Tuesday, September 9 at approximately 11:30 AM, a Chevrolet Silverado was traveling at a high rate of speed southbound on 18th Ave NW, near Maxbass. A 2015 Case Sprayer was eastbound on 93rd Street NW. The intersection of 93rd Street NW & 18th Avenue is an uncontrolled intersection. The Silverado collided with the Sprayer, striking the front left side of the sprayer wheel. The driver of the Silverado was transported to Trinity Health-Hospital by ambulance, where he later died of his injuries. The driver of the sprayer was not injured.

The crash remains under investigation by the North Dakota Highway Patrol.
