SLOPE COUNTY INJURY CRASH

What: Injury Crash

Where: Highway 21, MM 10, west of New England

When: Tuesday, January 20, 5:49 p.m. Mountain Time

Road Conditions: wet, blowing snow across the roadway

Weather Conditions: light snow

Crash Involvement: Vehicle/fixed object strike

Type of Crash: Roadway departure

Agencies Involved: North Dakota Highway Patrol, Slope County Sheriff's Office, Hettinger County Sheriff's Office, New England Ambulance, New England Fire

Vehicle No. 1: 2013 Dodge Caravan

Driver No. 1: Male, 64, Belfield, injured

Restraints: Seatbelt in use

Charges: Under investigation

Passenger No. 1: Female, 41, Belfield, serious injuries

Restraints: Seatbelt in use

NARRATIVE: On Tuesday, January 20 at approximately 5:49 p.m., a 2013 Dodge Caravan was traveling south on 126th Ave Southwest in Slope County. The driver missed the turn onto Highway 21 and traveled over the highway into a farmyard striking a parked car trailer. The driver and passenger were injured and taken to CHI St. Alexius Medical Center in Dickinson.

The crash remains under investigation by the North Dakota Highway Patrol.
