Walsh County Off-Highway Vehicle Injury DUI Crash Near Park River

What: Injury crash

Where: 135th Ave NE, approximately three miles south of Park River, ND

When: 4/6/2019, approximately 5:00 pm

Road Conditions: Good (gravel surface)

Weather Conditions: Cloudy

Crash Involvement: Single off-highway vehicle

Type of Crash: Tip-over

Agencies Involved: North Dakota Highway Patrol, Walsh County Sheriff's Office, Park River Ambulance

Vehicle No. 1:2017 Polaris Ranger side-by-side off-highway vehicleDriver No. 1:Joshua Jelinek; male; 35 years of age; of Pisek, ND; non-life-threatening injuriesRestraints:Seat belt not in use, not wearing a helmetCharges:DUI

Passenger No. 1: Trent Davidson; male; 29 years of age; of Pisek, ND; non-life-threatening injuries **Restraints:** Seat belt not in use, not wearing a helmet

NARRATIVE: Jelinek was driving the Polaris Ranger off-highway vehicle south on 135th Ave NE. Approximately three miles south of Park River, ND, a sudden steering action caused the Polaris to tip onto its passenger side. Jelinek and Davidson were transported by ambulance to First Care Health Center in Park River with non-life-threatening injuries.
