Fatal Crash – Interstate 94: Tappen, ND

What: Fatal Crash

Where: Interstate 94 mile marker 214 (North of Tappen, ND)

When: April 24th, 2019 at approximately 7:39 AM

Road Conditions: Normal / Dry

Weather Conditions: Clear

Crash Involvement: Single Vehicle

Type of Crash: 1-Vehicle Rollover

Agencies Involved: North Dakota Highway Patrol, Steele Police Department, Kidder County

Sheriff's Department, Kidder County Ambulance, Steele Fire Department and Sanford AirMed

Vehicle No. 1: 2005 Chrysler Town & Country
Driver No. 1: 38 year old female – Strasburg, ND
Restraints: Seatbelt - No. Airbags – Not Deployed.

Charges:

The 2005 Chrysler Town & Country was traveling eastbound on Interstate 94 near mile marker 214 (North of Tappen, ND). The vehicle left the roadway and entered the median. The driver steered back to the roadway and lost control. The vehicle rolled and came to rest in the south ditch. The driver was ejected from the vehicle and pronounced deceased at the scene. This crash remains under investigation by the North Dakota Highway Patrol.
