

## **Mountrail County Fatal Crash - Update with Names**

**What:** Fatal Crash

**Where:** US Hwy 2 MM 106, 8 miles East of Palermo

**When:** August 28, 2019 – 7:30 PM

**Road Conditions:** Normal

**Weather Conditions:** Clear

**Crash Involvement:** Motorcycle

**Type of Crash:** Rollover

**Agencies Involved:** Mountrail County Sheriff's Office, Berthold Fire & Ambulance, Northstar Air Ambulance, NDHP

**Vehicle No. 1:** 2007 Harley Davidson Motorcycle

**Driver No. 1:** Richard Bourre, Male, 51, Rainy River, Ontario, Fatal

**NARRATIVE:** The North Dakota Highway Patrol along with the Mountrail County Sheriff's Office investigated the following crash:

The motorcycle was traveling eastbound on Hwy 2 pulling a small trailer. Bourre lost control and the motorcycle and trailer began to rotate counter-clockwise. The motorcycle and trailer overturned and slid into the median. The motorcycle and trailer came to rest on its side in the median. Bourre and Collins were ejected while the motorcycle and trailer overturned.

Bourre was transported to Trinity hospital in Minot by Berthold Ambulance. He died at Trinity hospital due to injuries sustained in the crash.

Collins sustained serious injuries and was transported by Northstar air ambulance to Trinity hospital.

This crash remains under investigation.
