High Speed Chase on I94 in Bismarck Reaches 110 mph

Bismarck, ND – On Monday, Jan. 14, an North Dakota Highway Patrol Trooper responded to a report of a reckless driver traveling eastbound into Mandan. The vehicle was reported to be swerving all over the road. The Trooper located the vehicle on I94 by the Sunset exit in Mandan. The vehicle was observed speeding and the trooper followed the vehicle with lights activated. The driver increased speed to nearly 110 mph continuing east on I94. The pursuit continued on Expressway, where the driver eventually stopped on Expressway Bridge. The driver, Devon Wheeler, 18, Bismarck, was taken into custody without further incident, charges are pending.
