High Speed Pursuit in Traill County, ND

Hillsboro, ND - On Friday, January 25th, 2019, at approximately 11:49 pm, a North Dakota State Trooper encountered a motorist on Interstate 29 traveling northbound at 105 miles per hour in the 75 mile per hour zone. This occurred approximately five miles south of Hillsboro. The Trooper attempted to stop the vehicle for the speeding violation, but it fled. The Trooper, with the assistance of the Traill County Sheriff's Department, chased the suspect for approximately 10 miles on Interstate 29. The Sheriff's department was able to deflate the suspects tires with "tire deflation spikes", and the suspect was apprehended without incident approximately five miles north of Hillsboro. The suspect was identified as 22 year old Lucas Kulberg of Fargo, ND. Kulberg was transported to the Traill County Jail where he is facing criminal charges of Fleeing Law Enforcement in a Motor Vehicle and Driving Under Suspension.
