## UPDATED: Early Morning Crash in Williston Results in Single Fatality

WILLISTON, N.D. – At 12:35 am on Monday, December 31, the North Dakota Highway Patrol (NDHP) responded to a fatal crash on 32<sup>nd</sup> Ave West, Williston.

A 2018 Ford pickup, licensed by Dynamic Well Service, was northbound on 32<sup>nd</sup> Ave west when it drifted into the east ditch, striking a light pole which fell on the driver's side. The vehicle continued to spin counterclockwise in the ditch coming to rest facing southwest. The driver, 26-year old Daniel Navarrete-Resendiz, Perryton, TX, was pronounced dead on the scene.

The crash remains under investigation by the NDHP with assistance from the Williston Police Department and Williston Public Works.
