## Vehicle Pursuit

### **NARRATIVE:**

A Trooper with the North Dakota Highway Patrol attempted to stop a vehicle for excessive speeding along Morton County Road 139 (Old Highway 10); west of Mandan, Wednesday, July 10, at approximately 1:30 pm CST. The vehicle fled westbound on Morton County Road 139. The vehicle was identified as having fled from Mandan PD officers prior to meeting the NDHP Trooper.

The vehicle fled west on Morton County Road 139, south on Morton County Road 83 and then east on Lyons Road. Highway Patrol Troopers and Morton County Deputies set up a road block with tire disabling spike strips near the junction of Lyons Road and Morton County Road 139. The driver pulled over prior to the spike strips and was taken into custody without incident. The driver, identified as Keith Foster, was arrested on multiple warrants and charges stemming from this incident.
