Ward County – 2 Vehicle, Triple Fatality Crash

What: Fatality

Where: Hwy 23 Mile Marker 101, 14 Miles South and 4 Miles West of Minot, ND

When: July 15, 2019 @ Approximately 12:36 PM

Road Conditions: Good

Weather Conditions: Partly Cloudy

Crash Involvement: Vehicle/Vehicle

Type of Crash: Head-on which resulted in a vehicle fire

Agencies Involved: North Dakota Highway Patrol, New Town Ambulance Service, Max Ambulance Service, Max Fire and Rescue, Ward County Sheriff's Department

Driver No. 1: 78 yr old male, Douglas, ND, Fatal Injuries

Vehicle No. 2: 2017 Chevrolet Suburban
Driver No. 2: 28 yr old male, Parshall, ND, Fatal Injuries

Passenger No. 2: Juvenile Female, Parshall, ND

NARRATIVE: The Silverado was traveling west bound on Hwy 23. The Suburban was traveling east bound on Hwy 23. The Silverado crossed into the east bound lane of Hwy 23 and struck the Suburban head-on. The Silverado left the roadway to the south, coming to a rest upright, facing south, on the south slope of the highway. The Suburban left the roadway to the south, coming to a rest on the passenger side, facing east in the south ditch of the highway. The Suburban then started on fire and was fully engulfed in flames. This crash remains under investigation by the NDHP.
