## Motor Vehicle / Bicycle Injury Crash - Mayville, ND

**NARRATIVE:** On July 29, 2019, at 4:13 PM, Klath was traveling westbound on 3rd Street SW while Schafer was traveling southbound on 3<sup>rd</sup> Avenue SW. Schafer entered the intersection and was struck by Klath in the westbound lane of 3<sup>rd</sup> Street SW. Klath took evasive action by applying his brakes but was unable to avoid a collision. Schafer was transported to Sanford Mayville Medical Center by ambulance for injuries sustained in the crash.



The crash remains under investigation by the North Dakota Highway Patrol.
