NARRATIVE: The Dodge was traveling southbound on Highway 52 and the International truck was traveling northbound. Around mm 249, the Dodge crossed over the center line and entered the northbound lane. The International truck attempted to avoid the collision by steering to the right shoulder. The Dodge struck the front left side of the International truck. Both vehicles then entered the west ditch. The driver of the Dodge was extricated and



transported to Jamestown Regional Medical Center. The driver of the International was not hurt.

The crash remains under investigation by the North Dakota Highway Patrol.
