## **Injury crash Emmons County**

**What:** Injury crash

**Where:** Hwy 1804 / MM 45.8 – 13 miles West of Hazelton

**When:** June 10, 2019 1250 PM

**Road Conditions:** good

**Weather Conditions:** sunny

**Crash Involvement:** vehicle

**Type of Crash:** rollover

**Agencies Involved:** Hazelton Fire and Rescue / Emmons County Sheriff's Office / Linton Fire and Rescue, Emmons County Ambulance

**Vehicle No. 1:** 1999 International Boom Truck

**Driver No. 1:** Jacob Bernard Coulson, 28, River Falls, WI non-life-threatening injury

**Restraints:** unknown

**Charges:** under investigation

**NARRATIVE:** Mr. Coulson was traveling southbound on Hwy 1804 near mile marker 45.8 in Emmons County. He was traveling from Dickinson, ND to Bowdle, SD. The 1999 International Boom truck right tires went off the roadway and onto the west shoulder. Mr. Coulson maneuvered the vehicle towards the left causing it to go into the left (northbound) lane. Mr. Coulson then attempted to maneuver the vehicle towards the right (over-correct). The vehicle then rolled onto its left side and slide to a stop partially in the east ditch and northbound traffic lane.

Mr. Coulson was extricated from the vehicle and transported to Sanford Hospital in Bismarck for non-life-threatening injuries.
