

McLean County Motorcycle Fatality

What: Fatal Crash

Where: Highway 1804, 22 miles south of Parshall, McLean County,

When: Saturday, June 15, 11:30 am

Road Conditions: Dry

Weather Conditions: Cloudy, windy

Crash Involvement: Motorcycle – loss of control

Type of Crash: Motorcycle rolled, throwing driver

NARRATIVE: At 11:30AM on Saturday, June 15, a 69-year-old male, Larry Snyder, from Parshall was involved in a motorcycle crash on Highway 1804, about 22 miles south of Parshall. Snyder lost control of his motorcycle on the west shoulder and rolled the bike down into the ditch. The White Shield Ambulance transported him to Garrison Memorial Hospital and he was later transferred by Trinity Hospital Life Flight to Trinity Hospital in Minot. Snyder died at Trinity Hospital on June 16. The crash remains under investigation.
