Fatal Crash – Intersection of 25th St. SE & 158th Ave SE – rural Cass County

What: Two vehicle fatal crash

Where: Intersection of 25th St. SE & 158th Ave SE – approximately 3 miles NE of Amenia

When: June 24th, 2019 at approximately 4:30 pm

Road Conditions: Dry

Weather Conditions: Clear

Crash Involvement: Pickup vs. a Semi-Truck

Type of Crash: Intersection, right angle crash (T-Bone crash)

Agencies Involved: NDHP, Cass County SO, FM Ambulance, Casselton FD, Arthur FD, Cass

Vehicle No. 1: 2002 Peterbilt towing a 2012 belly dump trailer - empty

Driver No. 1: 37 YOA female – not injured

Restraints: Seat belt worn

Charges: None

Vehicle No. 2: 2006 Ford F150

Driver No. 2: 87 YOA male - deceased

Restraints: none used

Charges: n/a

NARRATIVE:

The Peterbilt was traveling eastbound on 25th St. SE (Cass County Road 4) when it approached the intersection with 158th Ave SE. Traffic on Co. Rd. 4 has the right of way.

The Ford was traveling southbound on 158th Ave SE. The driver of the Ford failed to yield to the Peterbilt. The Ford entered the intersection and was struck on the passenger side at a right angle.

After the collision, both the Peterbilt and Ford entered the southeast ditch at the intersection, where they both came to rest, upright.

The driver of the Peterbilt was not injured. The driver of the Ford was pronounced dead on scene, after life saving attempts were made.

The crash remains under investigation by the NDHP. The names of both parties will not be released until the evening of June 25th.
