Interstate 94 Property Crash (Bismarck, ND)

What: Property Crash

Where: Interstate 94, mile marker 157 (Bismarck, ND)

When: June 9, 2019 at approximately 2:03 PM

Road Conditions: Good/Normal – Construction Zone

Weather Conditions: Sunny/Clear

Crash Involvement: 2-Vehicle

Type of Crash: Rear End

Agencies Involved: North Dakota Highway Patrol

Vehicle No. 1: 2012 Ford F-150

Driver No. 1: Aaron Jordan, age 25, Bismarck, No injury

Restraints: Seatbelt

Charges: Failure to maintain control – reportable crash (distracted driving)

Vehicle No. 2: 2004 Chevrolet Cavalier

Driver No. 2: Lewis Goehring, age 18, Wishek, No injury

Restraints: Seatbelt

Passenger No. 1: David Goehring, age 56, Wishek, No injury

NARRATIVE: The 2004 Chevrolet was traveling westbound on Interstate 94 near mile marker 157. The 2012 Ford was also traveling westbound on Interstate 94 near mile marker 157 behind the Chevrolet. The driver of the Chevrolet slowed with westbound traffic due to road construction in the area. The driver of the Ford braked and turned but rear-ended the Chevrolet. The driver of the Ford was cited for "Failure to maintain control – reportable crash."

No injuries were reported with this crash. Traffic in the area was backed up until the scene could be cleared.
