NARRATIVE: Vehicle 1, driven by Jacob Hingtgen, was traveling northeast on County Rd 16 negotiating a curve in the roadway. Hingtgen lost control of his motorcycle. He was thrown off his motorcycle and landed on the roadway. He was transported to CHI St. Alexius Health in Williston for non-life-threatening injuries. Crash is still under investigation by the Highway Patrol.
