Strong Winds Cause Injury Semi Crash

What: Minor Injury Crash

Where: I-94, 4 miles east of Tower City

When: 9/2/2019 at 5:40 PM

Road Conditions: Wet

Weather Conditions: Heavy Rain and strong winds

Crash Involvement: Truck tractor and semi box trailer

Type of Crash: Tip over

Agencies Involved: Cass County SO, Casselton Ambulance, Buffalo Fire Department, Buffalo

Vehicle No. 1: 2019 Freightliner truck with box trailer

Driver No. 1: 22 year old Inder Singh of New York, NY. Minor injuries.

Restraints: seatbelt

Charges: no charges filed

NARRATIVE: A truck pulling an empty box trailer was westbound on I-94. A strong crosswind created by a severe thunderstorm tipped the semi over onto it's left side. The semi partially blocked the westbound lane. The driver was transported to Essentia for non-life threatening injuries. Interstate 94 westbound lane was closed for about 30 minutes to recover the vehicle.
