Boom Truck Crane Injury Crash

NARRATIVE: Vehicle 1 was traveling northbound on County Rd 55 when it drove off the roadway to the right. Driver overcorrected to get back on the roadway and lost control of the vehicle. Vehicle overturned coming to rest on its passenger side in the roadway. Driver sustained serious injuries and was transported first by ambulance then airlifted to Trinity Hospital in Minot. Crash is still under investigation by the Highway Patrol.
