## **Boom Truck Crane Injury Crash**

**What:** Injury

**Where:** County Road 55 about half mile north of Highway 23 roundabout (3 miles north of Keene)

**When:** 10:40 AM on 9/4/19

**Road Conditions:** Dry

**Weather Conditions:** Clear

**Crash Involvement:** Vehicle

**Type of Crash:** Rollover

**Agencies Involved:** North Dakota Highway Patrol, Mckenzie County Sheriff Department, Valley Air Med, Mckenzie County Ambulance, Keene Fire Department and First Responders

**Vehicle No. 1:** 2015 Kenworth Crane Boom Truck

**Driver No. 1:** 40-year-old male from Pascagoula, MS, Serious Life-Threatening injuries

**Restraints:** Unknown

**Charges:** Under Investigation

**NARRATIVE:** Vehicle 1 was traveling northbound on County Rd 55 when it drove off the roadway to the right. Driver overcorrected to get back on the roadway and lost control of the vehicle. Vehicle overturned coming to rest on its passenger side in the roadway. Driver sustained serious injuries and was transported first by ambulance then airlifted to Trinity Hospital in Minot. Crash is still under investigation by the Highway Patrol.
