UPDATE: Fatal Crash in Burleigh County

What: Fatal Crash

Where: Burleigh County, 5 miles west of Regan, on Highway 36

When: 02/13/19 at 6:50 a.m.

Vehicle No 1: 1996 Dodge Ram

Driver No. 1: Tim Allen Field, 61 yoa, Regan, ND, fatal

Airbag deployed

Vehicle No 2: 1978 Fitallis Payloader

Driver No. 2: Daniel Joseph Schonert, 52 yoa, Wilton, ND, uninjured

No safety restraints

Agencies Involved: Burleigh County Sheriff Department, Wilton Fire and Rescue, Wilton Rural Ambulance

The 1996 Dodge Ram, driven by Tim Allen Field, 61, Regan, was westbound on HWY 36 when it rear-ended the 1978 Fitallis Payloader, driven by Daniel Joseph Schonert, 52, Wilton, which also was headed west on HWY 36. The Ram came to rest in the north ditch and the Payloader came to rest on the shoulder of HWY 36 facing west. Field, the driver of the Dodge pickup died on scene. The crash remains under investigation by the NDHP.
