Injury Crash I-94 and 5th St. S Fargo

Fargo, ND – At approximately 0800 a Ford Explorer traveling west on I-94 lost control and left the northside of the roadway. The Ford struck the bridge barrier of the 5th Street South overpass, which travels underneath I-94. After striking the bridge barrier the Ford overturned and went over the barrier. The Ford fell approximately 10 feet landing on the 5th Street South sidewalk east of the roadway. The final resting position of the Ford was on the roof facing southwest. 5th Street South was close to traffic for approximately one hour with the assistance of the Fargo Police Department and Fire Department while the crash was investigated, and the Ford was removed. The Ford was occupied by the driver and one passenger, both were wearing seat belts at the time of the crash. The two occupants in the Ford sustained minor injuries, declining medical treatment from FM Ambulance and were not transported to a hospital. There were no other vehicles involved in this crash. Enforcement action was taken against the driver for Care Required.
