Rolette County Crash Injures Three **UPDATED**

What: Injury crash involving one vehicle

Where: 96th Street NE, ½ mile east of ND Hwy 30 (approximately 3.5 miles south of Rolla, ND)

When: 05/10/2019, at approximately 9:30 AM

Road Conditions: Good. Gravel surface.

Weather Conditions: Clear

Crash Involvement: Single vehicle

Type of Crash: Rollover

Agencies Involved: NDHP, Rolette County Sheriff's Office, BIA, Rolla Fire & Ambulance

Vehicle No. 1: 1997 Chevrolet ½-ton pickup

Driver: **Calvin Davis**; male; 19 years of age; of Fargo, ND; life-threatening injuries

Restraints: Seat belt not in use.

Passenger No. 1: **Justin Brunelle**; male; 27 years of age; of Belcourt, ND; life-threatening injuries

Restraints: Seat belt not in use.

Passenger No. 2: juvenile female; 17 years of age; of Belcourt, ND; non-life-threatening injuries

Restraints: Seat belt not in use.

Charges: Under investigation

NARRATIVE: The Chevrolet was traveling east on 96th Street NE. It began to leave the roadway, and the driver lost control. The vehicle overturned. **Davis and Brunelle** were ejected and were transported by ambulance to Presentation Medical Center in Rolla with life-



threatening injuries. The juvenile female occupant was transported by ambulance to Presentation Medical Center with non-life-threatening injuries.

The crash remains under investigation by the Highway Patrol.
