Rolette County Crash Injures Three

What: Injury crash involving one vehicle

Where: 96th Street NE, ½ mile east of ND Hwy 30 (approximately 3.5 miles south of Rolla, ND)

When: 05/10/2019, at approximately 9:30 AM

Road Conditions: Good. Gravel surface.

Weather Conditions: Clear

Crash Involvement: Single vehicle

Type of Crash: Rollover

Agencies Involved: NDHP, Rolette County Sheriff's Office, BIA, Rolla Fire & Ambulance

Vehicle No. 1: 1997 Chevrolet ½-ton pickup

Occupant No. 1: male; 19 years of age; of Fargo, ND; life-threatening injuries

Restraints: Seat belt not in use.

Occupant No. 2: male; 27 years of age; of Belcourt, ND; life-threatening injuries

Restraints: Seat belt not in use.

Occupant No. 3: female; 17 years of age; of Belcourt, ND; non-life-threatening injuries

Restraints: Seat belt not in use.

Charges: Under investigation

NARRATIVE: The Chevrolet was traveling east on 96th Street NE. It began to leave the roadway, and the driver lost control. The vehicle overturned. The two male occupants were ejected and were transported by ambulance to Presentation Medical Center in Rolla with life-threatening injuries. The female occupant was transported by ambulance to Presentation Medical Center with non-life-threatening injuries.

The crash remains under investigation by the Highway Patrol.
