## **Fatality Crash McIntosh county (names released)**

**What:** Fatality

**Where:** Hwy 11 MM 16, 20 miles west of Ashley.

**When:** 5/2/19 @ 1248 pm

**Road Conditions:** Good

**Weather Conditions:** Sunny and clear

**Crash Involvement:** one vehicle

**Type of Crash:** roll-over

**Agencies Involved:** McIntosh Sheriff, Ashley ambulance, Ashley Fire/Rescue

**Vehicle No. 1:** 2006 Chevy Impala 4-dr passenger car

**Driver No. 1:** male, 28 years old, Kahlor Michael Krefting, Mandan, ND. Serious injuries

**Restraints:** unknown seat belt usage, airbags deployed

**Charges:** under investigation

**Passenger No. 1:** Female, 23 years old, Courtney Elizabeth Degree, Mandan, ND. Fatal

**Restraints:** no seatbelt, ejected from the vehicle, air bags deployed

**NARRATIVE:** The 2006 Chevy Impala was traveling west on HWY 11 from Ellendale to Bismarck. The vehicle was traveling around 60 MPH when the driver lost control of it in a curve with fresh chip seal applied to the roadway. The vehicle entered the west ditch and rolled over ejecting the female passenger. Both the driver and passenger were transported to the Ashley Medical Center where the passenger passed away from injuries sustained in the crash. The driver was transported by ambulance to Sanford hospital in Bismarck.
