Wrong Way Driver Fatality Crash **UPDATE**

NARRATIVE: State Radio received a call of a wrong way driver on US 2 between Stanley and Ross traveling west bound. The call was dispatched to area law enforcement. A few minutes later, a call came in reporting a head-on crash approximately 3 miles west of Ross.

Near the crest of a hill, Brandt was traveling the wrong way and met two east bound vehicles. The driver of the first east bound vehicle was able to avoid collision. The second east bound vehicle, driven by Ladue, was unable to avoid the collision with Brandt's vehicle. The driver's side front ends of the vehicles hit head-on in the east bound lanes of US 2. Ladue's Dodge spun and came to rest in the inside lane facing north. Brandt's Nissan overturned in the median coming to rest on the driver's side facing north. Brandt and Shalev were both ejected from the Nissan. Shalev died at the scene.
