

**Update - Williams County Injury Crash**

**What:** Injury Crash

**Where:** Hwy 1804 MM 327, 4 miles North of Trenton

**When:** November 9, 2019 9:45 PM

**Road Conditions:** Dry with scattered patches of snow

**Weather Conditions:** Snowing, Windy

**Crash Involvement:** Vehicle

**Type of Crash:** Rollover

**Agencies Involved:** NDHP, Williams County Sheriff's Office, Trenton Fire & Rescue, Williston Rural Fire, Williston Ambulance, Williston City Fire

**Vehicle No. 1:** 2004 Jeep Grand Cherokee

**Driver No. 1:** Jordan Kaminski, Male, 29, Manistee, MI, serious injuries

**Restraints:** Seat belt in use

**Charges:** Under Investigation

**NARRATIVE:** The Jeep was traveling Northbound on Hwy 1804. The Jeep ran off the roadway into the East ditch, overturned, and came to rest in a field. Kaminski was trapped in the vehicle and was extricated by Fire and EMS. Kaminski was transported by Williston Ambulance to CHI St Alexius hospital in Williston and later flown by air ambulance to Trinity hospital in Minot.

This crash remains under investigation.
