UPDATE Cattle Hauler Rollover Crash – Emmons County

What: Property Crash

Where: Hwy 83 mm 41.5, (Hazelton, ND)

When: 10/30/2019 at 1400

NARRATIVE: A Freightliner truck transporting cattle was traveling southbound on US Highway 83. The truck slowed to make a left turn into the Cenex gas station in Hazelton, ND. As the vehicle began to turn, the weight of the cattle shifted. The vehicle overturned onto its right side where it came to rest on the approach and partially in the ditch. The trailer was loaded with approximately 72 head of cattle. Several cattle were killed during the crash and several more were later euthanized due to their injuries; 13 total.

This crash remains under investigation by the North Dakota Highway Patrol
