1 Vehicle Injury Crash in Williams County

NARRATIVE: Vehicle 1 was traveling southbound on US Highway 2. Driver drove off the roadway and entered the median. Vehicle struck a culvert and went air bound. Vehicle landed in the median striking the ground with the front of the vehicle. Driver and one of the passengers were ejected from the vehicle. Another passenger had to be extricated from the vehicle. Both passengers were air lifted to Trinity Hospital in Minot by Valley Air Med. Driver was transported to CHI St. Alexius Hospital in Williston. All occupants sustained serious life-



threatening injuries. Names are being withheld at this time until family can be notified. Crash remains under investigation by the Highway Patrol.
