Expressway Bridge Injury Crash – Bismarck-Mandan, ND

What: Injury Crash

Where: Expressway Bridge (westbound) between Bismarck and Mandan, ND

When: 10/31/19 at ~1727 hrs

Road Conditions: Good

Weather Conditions: Clear

Crash Involvement: 2-vehicle

Type of Crash: Rear-End

Agencies Involved: Bismarck Police Department, Bismarck Fire Department and Metro Ambulance Service

Vehicle No. 1: 2005 Chevrolet Equinox

Driver No. 1: Female - 23 yrs old - Dickinson, ND – non-life threatening injuries

Restraints: Not restrained. Airbags deployed.

Charges: Under Investigation

Vehicle No. 2: 2000 Ford Ranger

Driver No. 2: Male – 50 yrs old – Bismarck, ND – non-life threatening injuries

Restraints: Seatbelt. No airbags.

Charges: Under Investigation

Passenger No. 1: Male – 78 yrs old – Bismarck, ND – non-life threatening injuries

Restraints: Not restrained. No airbags.

NARRATIVE:

Both the Ford and Chevrolet were traveling westbound on the Expressway Bridge between Bismarck and Mandan. The driver of the Ford slowed and/or stopped on the roadway after

losing a bag of leaves out of their cargo box. The Chevrolet rear-ended the Ford. Both westbound lanes of the Expressway Bridge were blocked until the scene could be cleared. Vehicle occupants were treated for non-life threatening injuries.

This crash remains under investigation by the North Dakota Highway Patrol
