COMMUNITY MEDICAL SERVICES

- CMS is an Arizona based company with 45 clinics throughout the US. In ND we are open in Minot, Fargo and now Grand Forks.
- We offer outpatient Medication Assisted Treatment for opioid and heroin addiction, using medications such as Methadone and Suboxone.
- No referral is needed for clients. We utilize ND, and MN Medicaid as well as the SUD voucher for cost coverage.



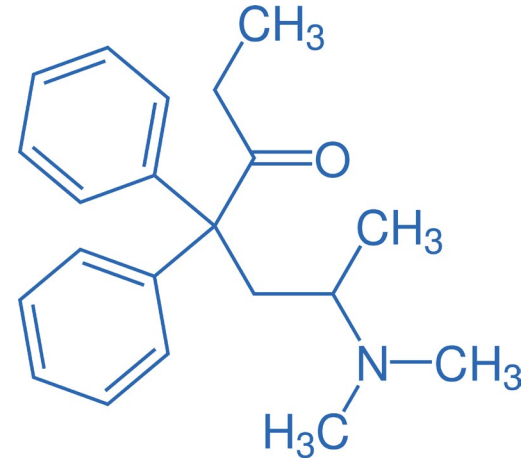
SERVICES OFFERED

- Treatment is for adults 18 and older.
- Treatment for pregnant women with opioid addiction issues.
- Counseling and Medical Provider visits are requirements for the program.
- Case management to help guide clients to other area resources if needed.
- Peer support.
- Narcan access.



HOW DOES MAT WORK ?

- Eliminates withdrawal symptoms like pain and relieves drug cravings.
- It blocks the “high” of heroin and other opioids by working on the same receptors in the brain.
- Has been used successfully for more than 40 years to treat opioid use disorder.
