NDHP Overview

The North Dakota Highway Patrol (NDHP) works diligently every day to **empower people**, **improve lives** and **inspire success**.

The NDHP is divided into two main components: **field operations** and **administration**. Field operations include the west, east, and motor carrier divisions. Administration includes finance, safety and education, support services, human resources, and the Law Enforcement Training Academy (LETA).

The NDHP remains committed to fulfilling our public safety mission and providing professional law enforcement services to North Dakota citizens and the motoring public.

Troopers on active patrol directly impact driver behavior. Our core areas of focus are **DUI, right-of-way, speeding, occupant protection, criminal laws, protecting infrastructure**, and **commercial motor vehicle safety**.

Important field operations programs that contribute to our success are the **canine pro**gram, crash reconstruction team, emergency response team, drug recognition experts, aircraft operations, motor carrier safety assistance program (MCSAP) and size and weight program.

NDHP troopers work diligently to provide education to the public to enhance crashreducing, responsible driving behavior. In 2018, troopers gave 384 safety presentations to a variety of educational institutions, civic organizations, and the general public.

In 2018, **178,954 permits** were issued. The automated routing permit system processed **175,011 (98%)** of these permits. An NDHP employee reviewed **6.8%** of permits.

The LETA provides basic training for peace officers and correctional officers as well as advanced training for law enforcement officers. One thousand two students representing local, state, county, and federal agencies graduated from the LETA in 2018.

The mission of the **North Dakota Highway Patrol** is to make a difference every day by providing high quality law enforcement services to keep North Dakota safe and secure.
