### SUMMARY OF WORK

Capitol Security Officers are an integral part of the North Dakota Highway Patrol team and are responsible for the safety of executive, legislative and judicial officials, state employees and visitors. Capitol Security provides the primary response to emergencies and security at events held on the Capitol grounds. This position is part time, approximately 20 hours per week. Benefits are not included with this position.

- Rotating shifts include nights, weekends, and holidays
- Patrol buildings and grounds
- Monitor security cameras and alarms
- Provide security for the Supreme Court
- Facilitate property access by authorized personnel
- · Warn violators of rule infractions such as loitering, smoking, or possession of contraband items
- Investigate and document injuries and accidents
- · Fingerprinting and printing of identification cards for State employees
- · Regulate traffic and parking, assist in vehicle accident investigations on state property
