Communication Philosophy

ALL methods of communication, appropriate to the needs of the individual camper are used by the camp staff to ensure understanding. These methods include: speech, writing and sign language.

The Camp's Aero-dynamic Staff

Camp staff includes dedicated and enthusiastic adults, including those who are deaf and hard of hearing, who are experienced with camping. Camp involves about one counselor for every three to five campers and is overseen by a camp director.
