



AUDIOLOGIST/SPEECH LANGUAGE PATHOLOGIST
GRADE N

SCOPE OF WORK:

Work involves providing diagnostic evaluations of hearing; preventive, habilitative, and rehabilitative services for auditory problems; or may specialize in diagnosis and treatment of speech and language problems.

DUTIES PERFORMED:

- Administer and interpret language, speech, and/or hearing tests.
- Apply clinical techniques of therapy to individuals with communication disorders.
- Determine language, speech, and/or hearing therapy case schedules.
- Participate in appropriate family counseling.
- Serve as a member of a multidisciplinary evaluation and treatment team.
- Provide work direction and guidance to language, speech, and/or hearing specialists.
- Prepare reports and documents relating to patient evaluation and treatment programs.

NOTE: The duties listed are not intended to be all-inclusive. Duties assigned any individual employee are at the discretion of the appointing authority.

MINIMUM QUALIFICATIONS:

Requires a Master's degree in the area of speech language pathology or audiology and eligibility for licensure in North Dakota (NDCC Chapter 43-37-02).
