SCOPE OF WORK:

Work involves providing preventative, therapeutic, and educational services for the control of oral diseases of residents within a state facility.

DUTIES PERFORMED:

- Provide clinical prophylaxis and oral hygiene services to residents.
- Coordinate a state facility's dental services by developing, monitoring, and maintaining comprehensive, high quality dental care for the residents.
- Serve as a resource for individual health plan teams concerning oral health for individuals residing in a state facility.
- Conduct training for various levels of staff to optimize oral health of residents.
- Provide instruction to direct care staff to assure that the clients are properly prepared to receive treatment.

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MINIMUM QUALIFICATIONS:

Requires graduation from an approved school of dental hygiene, licensure by the North Dakota State Board of Dental Examiners, and two years of professional work experience as a dental hygienist.
