ROTARY DRILL OPERATOR

GRADE K*

SCOPE OF WORK:

Work involves skilled operation of rotary drilling equipment used to drill test holes and install observation wells.

DUTIES PERFORMED:

- Operate, maintain, and repair drilling equipment such as rotary drill rig, water trucks, air compressors, pumps, etc.
- Drill test holes and wells; identify basic soil and rock formations that are being drilled; install and maintain all necessary hardware; ensure proper operation of pumping equipment.
- Collect water samples for chemical analyses.
- Evaluate condition of wells and methods to remedy non-functioning or malfunctioning wells; repair, renovate, or replace wells.
- Plug observation wells and restore sites.
- Maintain inventory of drilling supplies and equipment; estimate costs and initiate procurement.
- Record drilling activity and sampling information.
- Provide supervision to the drilling crew.

NOTE: The duties listed are not intended to be all-inclusive. Duties assigned any individual employee are at the discretion of the appointing authority.

MINIMUM QUALIFICATIONS:

Requires a high school diploma or GED and five years of increasingly responsible rotary drill operator experience.
